1. Indian Prosthodontic Society is a registered Society and has obtained registration u/s 12AA of the Income Tax Act with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2015 (Sl. No. 0237) vide UR No. AAAA13797H/05/15-16/T-0237 dated 26<sup>th</sup> Nov, 2015.
2. The Society's headquarters is in Chennai and during the year under review, the following branches of the Society were also functioning : Andhra Pradesh, Bengaluru, Chattisgarh, Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, Jaipur, Karnataka, Kerala, Odisha, Nagpur, Bhopal, Mumbai & Pune.
3. In the case of some branches, bank statements as at the end of the accounting period have not been furnished and hence the reconciliation with bank accounts are pending.
4. The audited financials received from Bengaluru, Chattisgarh, Kerala, Odisha, Gujarat & Jaipur all of which have been integrated in the Society's financials.
5. The Head Office of the Society has not received complete accounts or full clarifications from some of the branches and the consolidation of figures has been done only on the basis of incomplete information and to that extent the figures are subject to changes.
6. The surplus of 44<sup>th</sup> IPS Conference at Mumbai and 19<sup>th</sup> PG convention have been accounted at actuals, on the basis of accounts submitted by the respective branches.
7. Membership Fees are accounted on Receipt basis.
8. Royalty Income dues from Wolters & Kluwers have been accounted on accrual basis, as the relevant amounts have been subsequently received during the following financial year.
9. Service tax and Goods and Service Tax liabilities on membership fee have been duly discharged for the Financial Year.
10. The financials appended are provisional and are subject to audit as mandated by Income Tax Act and only after completion of the verification of financials and further clarifications from branches, the final audit report will be issued and then the income tax returns will be submitted to the authorities.
11. The amounts are rounded off to the nearest rupee.

## EXECUTIVE COUNCIL'S REPORT:

It's a pleasure & privilege to present the report of the Executive Council of the Society for the year 2017-18. The EC met 3times during the year at Hyderabad, Chennai& Hyderabad.

Promotion & creating awareness of the specialty among the general public has been the objective with which '**Prosthodontist Day**' was launched on January 22nd last year & this year we were joined by the Asian Prosthodontic fraternity in the commemoration. We are thankful to Members, Faculty, Students, Colleges, Regional Branches for their wholehearted participation and coming out with innovative programs to enhance public awareness of our specialty.

September 18<sup>th</sup> 2016 was a historic day for the Society. We became the first dental society in the country to inaugurate our own **permanent office in Hyderabad**. We have now started functioning from the office & have commenced continuing education programs in our own premises. Two programs – one on dental photography & the other on maxillofacial rehabilitation of midfacial defect with a live patient, were conducted in January & September this year. More niche programs & fellowship courses are being planned for the benefit of members. Our mobile app is also fully functional & can be downloaded from play store & app store. A smart membership card with QR code has been designed & will now be given to all members.

One of the unique programs of our Society is our **International Scientific Exchange with the Japan Prosthodontic Society**. This year also 3 young prosthodontic members of our Society have been selected to undergo specialized training in various universities in Japan. They are Dr. Roshan Kumar, Dr. Shylesh Kumar & Dr.Perna Kaushik. On behalf of all the members, we wish them the very best in their advanced education. This is the 10th year of this first of its kind collaboration between an Indian dental specialty organization & the Japan prosthodontic society.

As per the MOU signed with **ISMR**(International Society for Maxillofacial Rehabilitation), the 16<sup>th</sup> conference of the ISMR will be hosted for the first time in India in Pune in 2020 by the Society. This should give a huge fillip to maxillofacial prosthodontics in the country and affirm the growing stature of our Society internationally. Our EC member Dr.Srinivasan is currently the Vice-President of the ISMR, becoming the 1<sup>st</sup> Indian to hold this important post in this organization. We wish him the very best in his tenure. His efforts have ensured that the membership fee for this prestigious organization is now \$50 only for members of our society. We hope this will allow members to update their skills & knowledge & ensure development of maxillofacial prosthodontics in the country.

**The Journal of Indian Prosthodontic Society (JIPS)** has made significant progress in ranking and indexing status. JIPS obtained the Scopus cite score of 0.50, SJR - 0.319,



SNIP - 0.518 and Q3 position for this year. The SCI mago Journal & Country Rank (SJR) listing positions JIPS at 80 when compared to 94 and 98 in last 2 years, among dental journals in all regions/ country category. It is ranked at 9 amid the dental journals in Asiatic region when compared to 13 (11) and 17 in last 2 years. It is one among the top 3 dental journals (general category) in the country and it is considered as pioneer prosthodontic specialty journal in the country. The total number of articles submitted for the year 2018 is 302. The Journal has an acceptance rate of 7 % for the year 2018. In addition to the previous indexing agencies, the journal has been indexed in ESCI (emerging source citation Index – web of science) and DOAJ from this year. For the first time the editorial board and the IPS head office has planned to publish the conference proceedings of 11<sup>th</sup> Asian Academy conference and 46<sup>th</sup> IPS conference proceedings as two online supplementary issues. The abstracts of all faculty scientific deliberations will be available as conference proceedings. It can be downloaded from the IPS App, Journal and IPS websites. The publishing of conference proceedings shall aid in standardizing the conferences presentation, make it more acceptable by global scientific community and the details of the same shall be available all time.

The editorial board has conducted a pre convention workshop on scientific writing at 20<sup>th</sup>IPS PG Convention, Chennai for the benefit of student members. On popular request, the workshop is planned in upcoming 46<sup>th</sup> IPS conference, Mangalore to benefit both the students and life members. The hard copy of the journal back issues for the inspections or for academic needs are available in the head office. It shall be provided on request. For payments details and availability the requisite colleges or members can contact the IPS head office. The Journal is getting his global presence with the standard indexing status; we have more contributions from international authors. To further improve on our rankings we request all members to cite JIPS in all their publications. The sincere efforts by the editorial board over the years have brought in significant improvement in scientific value, universal presence and journal ranking. We duly acknowledge and appreciate the efforts of all authors, reviewers and editorial board members. We thank the Editor Dr. Gopi chander, Past Editors Dr. Suhasini Nagda, Dr.Ravindra Savadi & Dr.Shilpa Shetty for their immense contribution towards the development of our Journal.

**Community outreach program** is the society's endeavor to educate the general public & provide free treatment to needy. Dr Sunil Dhaded, Professor & Head, AME's Dental College, Raichur, in association with his department & ASHA workers who were deputed by the Govt of Karnataka organized 4 denture camps in and around Raichur District which benefited more than 100 elderly patients. Dr.Byju Kurien, HOD Prosthodontics, Annoor Dental College, Muvat tapuzha, organized a free denture camp & delivered removable prostheses to 50 patients. Dr.J.R.Patel & IPS Gujarat Branch had also been regularly conducting camps for the benefit of the elderly. The Haryana branch & Tamil nadu branch are in the process of organizing mega denture camps in the month of October & December respectively. All these camps are partly sponsored by the society. We encourage more members & regional branches to organize such socially useful outreach programs.



The **State/Regional branches** have now commenced all over the country. They pave the way for spreading the awareness of the specialty to the entire country. We now have 17 branches. All the branches have been prompt in submitting their accounts & fulfilling their GST obligations, which is extremely important for the head office to continue to enjoy the benefits of 12A income tax exemption. Most branches regularly conducted CDE programs, Master classes, outreach activities and also a regional conference. The head office is also in the process of signing an MOU with Ms. Colgate-Palmolive India Limited, to sponsor 3 CDE programs annually for each branch. We encourage all members to also become members of their respective regional branches.

The **Indian Board of Prosthodontics** is a premier flagship program of the Society to identify "Prosthodontists par excellence" in the country, through a countrywide exam conducted for the members of the IPS. The Board has been relentless in its search for Excellence in the field of Prosthodontics. A new team has taken over with Dr. T.V Padmanabhan as Chairman, Dr. Mohit Kheur as Vice-Chairman and Dr. Anand Krishna as Secretary. The next Part I exam has been Scheduled for the 15th of November 2018 in Mangalore whilst the Part II exam is scheduled to be held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> of October in Bangalore.

The **Council for Prosthodontic Research (CPR)** was formed last year to promote research among its members. The council proposes to invite research proposal from IPS members and member groups and grant funding for chosen projects. A very transparent application process was followed to enlist interested members to form the governing council of this research body. The following members were selected based on their publications & research capabilities. Their term would be for three years - Dr.Arvind Tripathi, Dr.Kanchan Dholam, Dr.Meena Aras, Dr.Akshay Bhargava, Dr.V.Anand Kumar, Dr.Kamal Shigli, Dr.N.Gopi Chander, Dr.Saamyendra V. Singh, Dr.Balendra Pratap Singh, Dr.Saeesh Deshmukh, Dr.Sunil Kumar Mishra & Dr.Pravin Kumar Patil. We thank the Council Chairman Dr.Mahendranadh Reddy, Secretary Dr.Mahadev shastry & other members involved for their efforts in this endeavor.

The **20<sup>th</sup> PG convention** was organized in July 2018 by IPS Tamilnadu branch & hosted by Chettinad Dental College, Chennai. There were over 1700 registrations for the convention, with 335 paper presentations, 285 Poster presentations, 108 table demonstrations, 72 participants for Teeth Arrangement, 58 for Tooth Preparation & 80 for Prostho Quiz competitions. For the first time cash prizes were being awarded in all the competitions Rs 5000 for the 1<sup>st</sup> prize and Rs 3000 for 2<sup>nd</sup> prize. The convention had 21 Keynote speakers in form of Lecture, debates and symposiums, with Dr.Murali Srinivasan delivering the Dr TM Udani Oration. For the first time, cultural and sports competitions were introduced in PG convention with 85 participants for the solo singing (Voice of Prosthodontics), 25 for Table Tennis & 58 for Badminton. b. To seek election to the Executive Council by any other Member, the aspiring Member shall have a minimum of six (6) years of good standing and shall have attended a minimum of three (3) IPS Conferences out of recent five (5) IPS Conferences.

41. Procedure for conducting elections :

Nomination for the vacant posts on the Executive Council shall be called by the Secretary-cum-Treasurer along with the notice of AGM. The last date of receipt of such nominations from the candidates shall be at least ten days prior to the date of AGM. The candidates shall send the nominations to the Secretary-cum-Treasurer on or before the last date and only Founder, Co-Founder and Ordinary Life Members with good standing are be eligible to contest.

One candidate is eligible to contest only for one post. If one applies to contest for more than one post, all the nominations of the Member shall be invalid automatically for all the posts.
